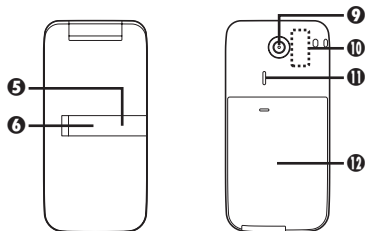
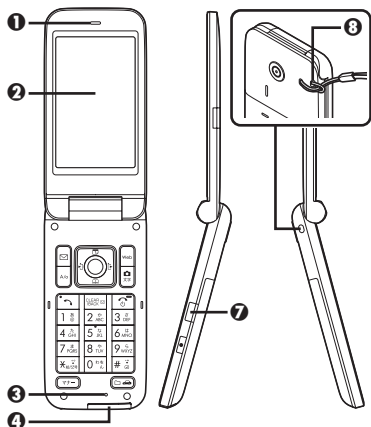

Port Cover

- Close Port Cover after External Device Port use.

Strap Eyelet

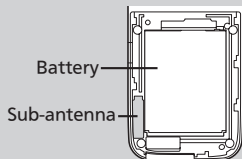
- Avoid metal Straps; may affect signal reception.

Internal Antenna Area

- Do not cover or place stickers, etc. over Internal Antenna area.

Sub-antenna

- Sub-antenna is attached inside handset (see below). Be careful not to peel it when removing Battery.



Handset Positions

■ Handset Closed

Keep handset closed when not in use.



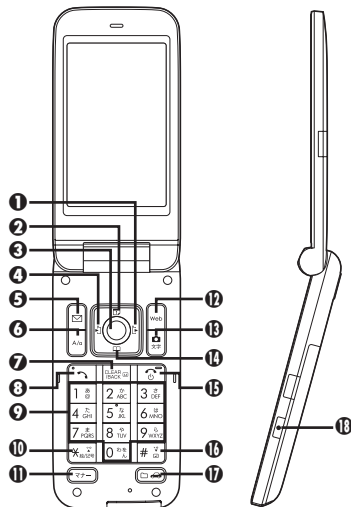
■ Handset Open

Open handset to place or answer calls, enter text, etc.



Handset Keys

- Keys are indicated in this guide as shown.



1 Multi Selector (right)

Open Call Log (Dialed).

2 Multi Selector (up)

Open Calendar. Long Press to open Information window.

3 Center Key

Open Main Menu. Long Press to activate/cancel Keypad Lock.

4 Multi Selector (left)

Open Call Log (Received). Long Press to open profile (My Details).

5 Mail Key

Open Messaging menu. Long Press to open E-mail Composition window.

6 Speed Dial & A/a Key

Open Speed Dial/Mail.

7 Clear/Back Key

Play Answer Phone messages. Long Press to activate/cancel Answer Phone.

8 Start Key

Open dial window.

9 Dialpad

Enter numbers. Long Press to open Phone Book.

10 * Key

Enter * and P. Long Press to send Location Information.

11 Mode & Manner Key

Select handset mode. Long Press to activate/cancel Manner mode.

12 Web Key

Open Browser menu. Long Press to access home page.

13 Camera & Text Key

Activate Camera. Long Press to open Camera menu.

14 Multi Selector (down)

Open Phone Book. Long Press to open new entry window.

15 Power & End Key

Long Press to power off.

16 # Key

Enter #. Long Press to activate/cancel Manner mode.

17 Data Folder & Drive Key

Open Data Folder. Long Press to active/cancel Drive mode.

18 Shutter Key

Handset Closed: Toggle Clock view.
Handset Open: Long Press to activate Camera.

Battery Installation

About Battery

- Charge Battery at least once every six months; uncharged Battery may die or affect files/settings.
- Depending on usage, bulges may appear near end of battery life; this does not affect safety.
- Replace Battery if operating time shortens noticeably.
- Clean Battery terminals and charging terminals with a dry cotton swab, etc.

Lithium-ion Battery

- Handset requires a lithium-ion battery. Lithium-ion batteries are recyclable.



- To recycle a used lithium-ion battery, take it to any shop displaying the symbol to the right.

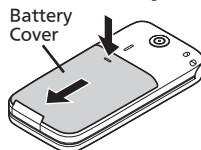

- To avoid fire or electric shock, do not short circuit or disassemble Battery.

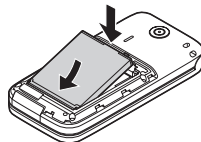
Inserting & Removing Battery

1 Remove Battery Cover



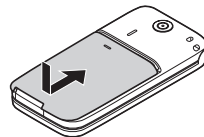
- Press and slide as shown.

2 Insert Battery



- With logo side facing up, align Battery terminals with contacts.

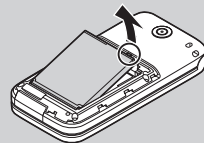
3 Replace Battery Cover



- Position and slide Battery Cover gently as shown all the way.

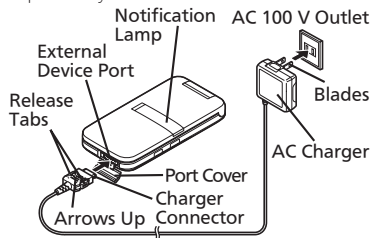
Removing Battery

- Power off and lift Battery as shown.



Charging Battery

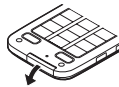
AC Charger is not included in the package; purchase XN-AAWP01 separately.



Important AC Charger Usage Notes

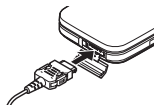
- Handset/AC Charger may become warm while charging.
- Retract blades after charging. Do not pull, bend or twist cord.
- Do not use commercial chargers that allow headphone use while charging; may cause malfunction.

- 1** Open Port Cover as shown



- Close handset after opening Port Cover.

- 2** Insert Charger connector to External Device Port



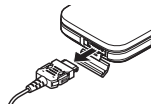
- 3** Extend blades and plug AC Charger into AC outlet



- Notification Lamp illuminates red while charging.
- Notification Lamp goes out when Battery is full.

- 4** Unplug AC Charger and retract blades

- 5** Remove Charger connector from handset



- Squeeze release tabs and pull straight out.

- 6** Replace Port Cover

- Standby appears.

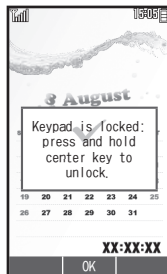
■ When Carrying Handset

Keep handset closed; activate Keypad Lock to prevent accidental operation.

- Press  to answer calls; Keypad Lock reactivates after the call.

Display

Standby

Most operations start from Standby. Indicators appear at the top of Display.

Information Window

Opens at the bottom for missed calls, new mail, etc.



- Information label (e.g., **Message**) and count appear. Select an item and press to open it.

Opening Unread Information



Display Saving

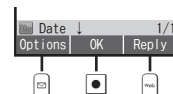
Display goes completely dark after Display Saving time elapses. Press any key (except during a call) to cancel Display Saving and reilluminate Display.

Backlight

- Backlight turns off after Time Out time elapses. Press - to illuminate it (key press may affect active function).
- Display goes completely dark during a call. (Backlight does not turn off first.)

Softkeys

Functions/operations assigned to , , and appear at the bottom of Display.



Submenus

- When **Options** appears, press corresponding key to open submenu for related functions/settings.



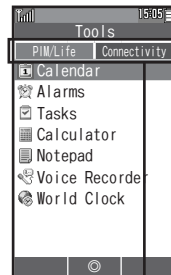

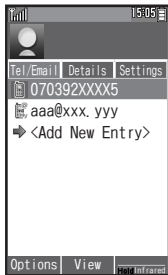

Mobile Manners

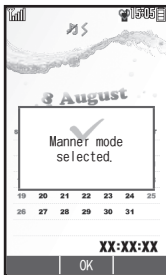
Please use your handset responsibly. Take care not to disturb others when using handset.

- Power off in theaters, museums and other places where silence is the norm.
- Refrain from use in restaurants, hotel lobbies, elevators, etc.
- Observe signs and instructions regarding handset use aboard trains, buses, etc.
- Refrain from use that interrupts the flow of pedestrian or vehicle traffic.

Manner Mode

Mute most handset function sounds.

- 1  (Long Press)




- Manner mode activates.

When Manner Mode is Active

- Ringtones and other sounds are muted.
- Handset vibrates for incoming transmissions, etc.
- Shutter click still sounds at fixed volume.

Canceling Manner Mode

- 1  (Long Press)

Drive Mode


Disable ringtones and Vibration for incoming transmissions. The caller will be notified that you are driving and cannot answer.

- Drive mode activates.

Canceling Drive Mode

- 1  (Long Press)

Offline Mode

Suspend signal transmission and reception.

- Handset will be unable to place/receive calls, send/receive messages, access the Internet, etc.

Security Codes

Handset Code and Administrator Code are required for handset use; save both codes beforehand.

Handset Code	Use or change some functions.
Administrator Code	Required for Reset Settings and Reset All.

- Do not forget Security Codes.
- Do not reveal Security Codes. We are not liable for misuse or damages.
- Guide descriptions are given assuming that Handset Code and Administrator Code are saved.

If Security Code is Unsaved

- Code setup message/window appears whenever Security Code is required.

Incorrect Code Entry

- Message appears for incorrect code entries; retry.

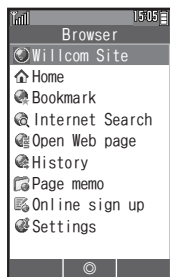
