

Phone Book Overview

Save phone numbers, mail addresses and other information, set handset responses to incoming calls/new messages, and more.

Name	Save first and last names with reading.
Phone Number	Save up to five phone numbers.
Split Bill	Set whether to use Split Billing service for all calls to the number.
Mail Address	Save up to five mail addresses.
Category	Classify contact into selected category.
Address	Save postal code, country, state/province, city, etc.
Office	Save company name, department and title.
Picture	Save an image that appears for incoming calls.
Ringtone & Vibration	Set responses to incoming transmissions.
Secret	Hide contact and require Handset Code for access.

- Save homepage, memo, blood type, birthday and star sign as needed.

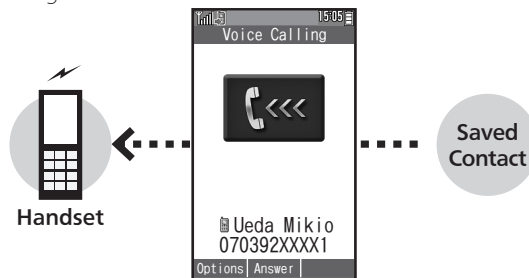
Back Up Important Information

If handset is left with no Battery inserted or an exhausted one, contacts may be altered/lost; handset damage may also affect information recovery. Keep separate copies of contacts, etc.

Incoming Calls from Saved Contacts

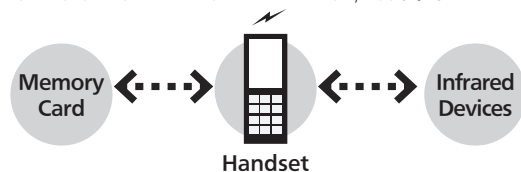
Name saved in Phone Book appears; image appears and handset responds with ringtone/Vibration according to settings.



Exchanging Files with Memory Card & Other Devices

Back up contacts to Memory Card on handset or transfer them to other devices using Infrared transmission.

Adding Contacts to Phone Book

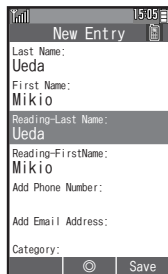
Saving Basic Items

Enter a name, phone number and mail address (enter at least one of these items) and classify the contact.

- 1 **Phone** → **Add New Entry**

- New entry window opens.

- 2 **Last Name:** → **Enter last name** → **First Name:** → **Enter first name**



- Characters entered for names (reading for kanji) appear.

- 3 **Add Phone Number:** → **Enter number** → **Select icon** → **Select line type**



- To save additional numbers, repeat 3.

- 4 **Add Email Address:** → **Enter mail address** → **Select icon**

- To save additional mail addresses, repeat 4.

- 5 **Category:** → **Select category**



- Set handset responses to incoming calls/new messages and save other information as needed. For details, see P.4-3.

- 6 **Save**

 - Contact is saved.

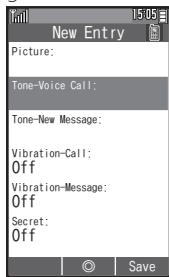
Enabling/Disabling Split Billing Service
After 3, **Split Bill:** → **On or Off** → **From 4**

- A separate subscription is required to use service. For details, see P.11-3.

Adding Contacts to Phone Book

Setting Responses to Transmissions

To set handset responses to incoming transmissions after setting basic items, follow these steps before saving contact.



■ Ringtones

- 1 In new entry window, **Tone-Voice Call:** or **Tone-New Message:** →

- 2 **Assign Tone** →
→ **Select folder** →
→ **Select tone/file** →
• New entry window returns.

Canceling Ringtone Setting
After 1, **Remove Tone** → → **Yes**
→

■ Vibration

- 1 In new entry window, **Vibration-Call:** or **Vibration-Message:** →

- 2 **Switch On/Off** → → **On**
→ → **Vibration Pattern**
→

- 3 **Select pattern** → → **Cancel**
• New entry window returns.

Canceling Vibration Setting
After 1, **Switch On/Off** → → **Off**
→ → **Cancel**

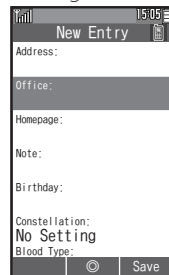
- 1 In new entry window, **Picture:** →

• New entry window returns.

After 1, **Take a Photo** → →
Frame subject on Display → →

Saving Additional Information

To save additional information after saving basic items, follow these steps before saving contact.



Adding Contacts to Phone Book

1 In new entry window, select item (e.g., **Address:**)
➔

2 Complete field or select item ➔

- New entry window returns. (For **Address:** and **Office:**, press after)

Hiding Contacts

Hide contact and require Handset Code for access.

1 In new entry window, **Secret:** ➔

2 **On** ➔

- New entry window returns.

Accessing Hidden Contacts

➔ ➔ **Unlock Temporarily** ➔
➔ Enter Handset Code ➔

Setting Responses by Category

1 ➔ **Phone** ➔
➔ **Set Category** ➔

2 Select category ➔

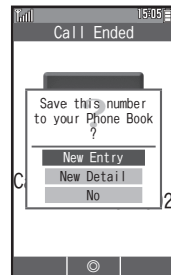
3 Select item ➔
➔ Select transmission type

4 Select item (e.g., **Assign Tone**) ➔ ➔ **Set**

Saving Numbers After Calls

After calls to/from unsaved numbers, save the number as follows.

1 After calls to/from unsaved numbers...



- Save to Phone Book confirmation appears.




2 **New Entry** ➔
➔ **Complete fields** ➔

Saving to an Existing Contact

In Save to Phone Book confirmation, **New Detail** ➔ ➔ Select contact ➔ ➔ Complete fields ➔

Using Phone Book

Dialing from Phone Book

- 1 
 - Contact search window (By あかさたな) opens.
- 2  Select tab (hiragana row, alphabet or *) for first character of last name
➔ Select contact ➔ 



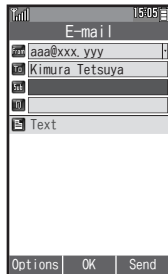
- Contact details window opens.

- 3  Select phone number ➔

- Omit number selection step if only one number is saved.

Sending Messages from Phone Book




- 1 In contact details window, select mail address ➔ 



- E-mail Composition window opens.

- 2 Complete message ➔ 

Sending Light Mail

- In contact details window, select phone number ➔  ➔ **Create Message** ➔  ➔ Complete message
➔ **Send** ➔ 

Opening from Other Functions


Example: Enter a recipient from Phone Book when sending E-mail.

- 1  ➔ **Create E-mail** ➔ 
- 2 Select recipient field ➔ 
➔  ➔ **Open Phone Book**
➔ 



- Contact search window opens.

- 3 Select contact ➔ 

- 4 Select mail address ➔ 
 - Recipient is entered.
 - Omit 4 if only one address is saved.

3 **Select method** → 

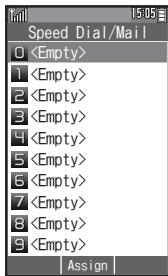
Changing Search Method Temporarily
In contact search window,  (press to toggle)

Using Speed Dial

Save phone numbers to Speed Dial/Mail list for easy dialing and messaging.

Saving Entries

- 1  → **Phone** →  → **Speed Dial/Mail** → 




- Speed Dial/Mail list appears.


- 2 **<Empty>** →  → **Select contact** → 

- 3 **Select phone number** → 

- Select mail address prompt appears.

- 4 **Select mail address** → 

- To complete entry without saving a mail address, select **Do not Assign** and press .

- 5 
 - Entry is saved.
