


# Text Entry Overview

## Text Entry Windows


When available, text entry window (such as the one shown to the right) opens while messaging or using Phone Book.

- Unless noted otherwise, descriptions in this chapter are for text entry windows.



## Character Types & Entry Modes

Enter hiragana, kanji, katakana (double-byte and single-byte), alphanumerics (double-byte and single-byte), symbols and pictograms. Switch entry modes as needed.



Use  to select mode 



## Text Entry Basics

Use Dialpad to enter characters. Multiple characters are assigned to each key. Press a key to toggle character options for that key.



- Press  to reverse-toggle options.



## Entering Characters Assigned to the Same Key

After typing a character, press  or Long Press that key.




# Entering Characters

## Hiragana

Enter すずき in Kanji (Hiragana) mode.

1

[Enter] (Confirm)



- Hiragana is entered.

## Kanji

Convert すずき to 鈴木.

1

Type すずき

- Word suggestions change as hiragana are typed. (Predictive)
- Long Press [Enter] to toggle suggestion mode between Standard, Literary, Spoken and Automatic. (Personal Mode)

[Enter] → Select 鈴木



- To exit suggestion list, press [Enter].

- Words likely to follow the entry appear. (Previous Usage)

## Segmenting Hiragana to Convert Separately

Before confirming entry, [Enter] or [Enter]

## toggling Conversion Method

Before confirming entry, [Enter]

- Press to toggle Predictive and Non-Predictive suggestions.

## Deleting Words/Phrases from Entry Log

Type hiragana → [Enter] → Select word/phrase → [Enter] (Long Press) → Yes → [Enter]


### Katakana

Switch to Double-byte Katakana mode and enter ジュン.

### Pictograms, Decorative Pictograms & Symbols


- May be unavailable depending on entry mode.
- Decorative pictograms are available for E-mail message text only.

- Entry window for pictograms, Decorative pictograms and symbols opens. (Log appears if any of these characters has been used.)

- List of pictograms, Decorative pictograms or symbols appears.
- In message text, press  in pictogram list to toggle Web pictograms and all pictograms.



Select pictogram, Decorative pictogram or symbol → 

- To exit, press .

### Alternative Emoticon Entry Method

- In Kanji (Hiragana) mode, type **かお** or a descriptive word such as **わーい** or **うーん**, then convert the entry.

# Using Various Conversion Methods

## Hiragana to Katakana/Alphanumeric Conversion

Enter katakana or alphanumerics in Kanji (Hiragana) mode using key inscriptions.

Example: Enter PM

Select word/phrase (PM)



## One-Hiragana Conversion

Type first hiragana and convert it to previously entered kanji.

Example: すずき was previously converted to 鈴木.

Select 鈴木 →

## Correction Conversion

After mistyping hiragana assigned to the same key (e.g., い instead of う), enter intended word/phrase from suggestion list without retyping.

- Available when three or more hiragana are typed.

Type hiragana → Before selecting word/phrase,

- Corrected word suggestions appear.

## Deleting & Editing



### 1 Select character





## Recovering Deleted Characters


- Press to recover characters deleted with .

## Deleting All Characters

- Long Press at text end. To delete characters on and after cursor, select the first character of text and Long Press .

## Copy/Cut & Paste


- ### 1

- To cancel and start over, press .
