

Phone Book Overview

Save phone numbers, mail addresses and other information, set handset responses to incoming calls/new messages, and more.

Name	Save first and last names with reading.
Phone Number	Save up to five phone numbers.
Split Bill	Set whether to use Split Billing service for all calls to the phone number.
Mail Address	Save up to five mail addresses.
Category	Classify contact into selected category.
Address	Save postal code, country, state/province, city, etc.
Office	Save company name, department and title.
Picture	Save an image that appears for incoming calls.
Ringtone & Vibration	Set responses to incoming transmissions.
Secret	Hide contact and require Handset Code for access.

- Save homepage, memo, birthday, star sign and blood type as needed.

Back Up Important Information

- If handset is left with no Battery inserted or an exhausted one, contacts may be altered/lost; handset damage may also affect information recovery. Keep separate copies of contacts, etc.
- We are not liable for any damages resulting from loss/alteration of contacts.

■ Incoming Calls from Saved Contacts

Name saved in Phone Book appears; image appears and handset responds with ringtone/Vibration according to settings.



■ Exchanging Contacts with Other Devices

Transfer contacts to other devices via Infrared transmission or Bluetooth®.

Saving Contacts to Phone Book

Saving Basic Items

Enter a name, phone number and mail address (enter at least one of these items) and classify the contact.

1 (Long Press)



- New entry window opens.

2 Last Name:

- ➔ Enter last name
- ➔ First Name:
- ➔ Enter first name



- Characters entered for names (reading for kanji) appear.

3 Add Phone Number:

- ➔ Enter phone number
- ➔ Select icon
- ➔ Select line type



- To save additional phone numbers, repeat 3.

4 Add Email Address:

- ➔ Enter mail address
- ➔ Select icon
- To save additional mail addresses, repeat 4.

5 Category:

- ➔ Select category



- Set handset responses to incoming calls/new messages and save other information as needed. For details, see P.4-3.

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


- Contact is saved.

Saving Contacts to Phone Book

Setting Responses to Transmissions

After saving basic items (before saving contact), set responses to incoming transmissions as follows.



■ Ringtones

- 1 In new contact entry window, **Tone-Voice Call**; **Tone-Bluetooth**; or **Tone-New Message**: →

- 2 **Assign Tone** →
 - Select folder →
 - Select tone/file →
 - New contact entry window returns.

Canceling Ringtone Setting
After 1, **Remove Tone** → → **Yes**
→

■ Vibration

- 1 In new contact entry window, **Vibration-Call**; **Vibration-Bluetooth**; or **Vibration-Message**: →

- 2 **Switch On/Off** → → **On**
→ → **Vibration Pattern**
→

- 3 **Select pattern** → →
 - New contact entry window returns.

Canceling Vibration Setting
After 1, **Switch On/Off** → → **Off**
→ →

■ Image

- 1 In new contact entry window, **Picture**: →

- 2 **Pictures** →
 - **Select image** →

- New contact entry window returns.

Capturing Image for Setting
After 1, **Take a Photo** → →
Frame subject on Display → →
Canceling Image Setting
After 1, **Remove Picture** → → **Yes**

Saving Additional Information

- 1 In new contact entry window, select item (e.g., **Address**): →

- 2 **Complete field or select item** →
 - New contact entry window returns. (For **Address**: and **Office**:, press after 2.)

Saving Contacts to Phone Book

Hiding Contacts

Hide contact and require Handset Code for access.

- 1 In new contact entry window, **Secret:** →

- 2 **On** →

- New contact entry window returns.

Accessing Hidden Contacts

- → **Unlock Temporarily** →
→ Enter Handset Code →

Setting Responses by Category

- 1 → **Phone** →
→ **Set Category** →

- 2 Select category →


- 3 **Assign Ringtone** or **Assign Vibration** → → **Select transmission type** →

- 4 Select item (e.g., **Assign Tone**) → → **Set**

- Restoring Default Category Settings
After 2, **Reset Settings** → → **Yes**

Saving Phone Numbers After Calls

- 1 After calls to/from unsaved numbers...



- Save to Phone Book confirmation appears.

- 2 **New Entry** →
→ **Complete fields** →

Saving to an Existing Contact

After 1, **New Detail** → → Select contact → → **Complete fields** →
Hiding/Showing Save to Phone Book Confirmation after Calls to/from

Unsaved Phone Numbers

- **Phone** → → **Settings/Manage** → → **Ph.Book Settings** →
→ **New Number Prompt** → → **Incoming Call or Outgoing Call** →
→ **On or Off** →

Using Phone Book

Dialing from Phone Book

1



- Contact search window (By あかさたな) opens.
- Press to change search method.

2

- Select tab (hiragana row, A or *) for first character of last name → Select contact →



- Contact details window opens.

3

- Select phone number →



- Omit phone number selection step if only one phone number is saved.


Placing Calls via Smartphone Link

- After 2, select phone number →
- **Bluetooth Call** →

Sending Messages from Phone Book

1

- In contact details window, select mail address →



- E-mail composition window opens.

2

- Complete message →

Sending Light Mail

- In contact details window, select phone number → → **Create Message** → → Complete message → **Send** →

Opening from Other Functions

Example: Enter a recipient from Phone Book when sending E-mail.

1  (Long Press)

2 Select recipient field  
   **Open Phone Book**
 



- Contact search window opens.

3 Select contact  

4 Select mail address  

- Recipient is entered.
- Omit **4** if only one mail address is saved.



Using Speed Dial

Save phone numbers to Speed Dial/Mail list for easy dialing and messaging.

Saving Entries

- To complete entry without saving a mail address, select **Do not Assign** and press .
